Two of these should be from a high school teacher or college instructor who is familiar with your academic work, while the third should be from someone knowledgeable about your extracurricular, athletic or employment activities. Complete, sign and photocopy the enclosed recommendation/appraisal forms and send them to the individuals from whom you are seeking a recommendation. Request that they complete and return the form to the Michigan Equine Scholarship Fund Scholarship Committee as promptly as possible (notify them of the application deadline). It may be helpful if you provide these individuals with a stamped envelope addressed to the Scholarship Committee.

#### **H. Applicant Certification**

### Michigan Equine Scholarship Fund Scholarship Application Checklist

Enclose transcript of grades (generated and certified by the registrar's office of your current school). Please note that your latest report card is not an official transcript.
If you will be a freshman or are transferring from one school to another, enclose a copy of the acceptance letter from the college you will attend.
Enclose three letters of recommendation (makes copies of appraisal form if necessary).
Signed equine organization letter or copy of valid membership card.

### ALL MATERIALS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE APRIL 1ST APPLICATION DEADLINE.

If you have not yet received your letter of acceptance from the college you will attend, please forward a copy of the letter as soon as it is available.
